

**BRIDGER BOWL INC.
2009 - 2010 SEASON PASS AGREEMENT, NOTIFICATION OF RISK / RELEASE OF LIABILITY
***** PLEASE READ CAREFULLY *******

The following information outlines Bridger Bowl Inc., pass policies and regulations. It is imperative pass holders follow these rules and agree in writing to be bound by the policies and conditions of this agreement. In issuing this pass, Bridger Bowl Inc., makes no guarantees as to opening date, closing date, days of operation, lifts or trails in operation, snow conditions, availability of parking, or availability of added value benefits. The pass holder agrees to visibly wear his/her pass or ticket whenever loading any chair lift and present it upon demand for inspection.

Users of Bridger Bowl Ski Area are required to abide by "Your Responsibility Code", Bridger Bowl Inc. Mountain Regulations and Montana State Law, Section 23-2-736, 23-2-735, 23-2-704 and 23-2-702 MCA. Regulations are enforced. Bridger Bowl Inc., reserves the right to cancel a pass and/or ticket without a refund and may refuse future purchase of pass and/or ticket for failure to comply with the mountain regulations and/or disregard for the safe use of lifts, slopes, other facilities at the area or transportation services. This includes, but is not limited to: furnishing fraudulent information on your season pass application; failure to present ticket/pass; use of your pass/ticket by another person; reckless skiing; skiing fast in slow skiing areas; excessive speed; tucking; crossing the area boundary (except at designated gates and access zones); skiing in a closed area; skiing under rope closure lines; failure to use retention devices; theft of goods, services or equipment; disorderly conduct; vandalism; abusive profanity; intoxication; lift line violations; and parking violations.

If your pass is lost or stolen, you must report it immediately to the Ticket Office.

NO REFUNDS - NON TRANSFERRABLE

NOTIFICATION OF RISK / RELEASE OF LIABILITY

I hereby voluntarily request that Bridger Bowl Inc. issue me and/or my minor child(ren) a pass in accordance with the terms of this agreement. I understand there are inherent dangers and risks of skiing that are part of the sport including: changing weather conditions; snow conditions as they exist or as they may change, including ice, hardpack, powder, packed powder, wind pack, corn snow, crust, slush, cut-up snow, and machine-made snow; avalanches, except on open, designated ski trails; collisions with natural surface or subsurface conditions, such as bare spots, forest growth, rocks, stumps, streambeds, cliffs, trees, and other natural objects; collisions with lift towers, signs, posts, fences, enclosures, hydrants, waterpipes, or other artificial structures and their components; variations in steepness or terrain, whether natural or the result of slope design, snowmaking, or snow grooming operations, including but not limited to roads, freestyle terrain, ski jumps, catwalks and other terrain modifications; collisions with clearly visible or plainly marked equipment, including but not limited to lift equipment, snowmaking equipment, snow grooming equipment, trail maintenance equipment and snowmobiles, whether or not the equipment is moving; collisions with other skiers; the failure of a skier to ski within that skier's ability; skiing in a closed area or skiing outside the ski area boundary as designated on the ski area trail map; and restricted visibility caused by snow, wind, fog, sun, or darkness. I am aware that natural and man-made obstacles exist. Fencing, equipment covers, signs, rope lines and other marking devices may be in place and mark some, but not all, of the potential obstacles or hazards. These markers will not prevent injury. I understand it is my responsibility to stay away from marked areas. I acknowledge the existence of these risks and accept such risks, on behalf of myself and/or my minor child(ren), whether they are marked or unmarked.

I am aware that there are inherent and other risks for persons who are in the process of approaching, loading, unloading and departing from aerial chairlifts. I understand that all persons who use an aerial chairlift shall be presumed to have sufficient ability and physical dexterity or personal assistance to negotiate and be evacuated from the aerial chairlift safely.

I am aware that skiing and using aerial chairlifts may result in serious injury, death, property damage and economic loss from these risks and I accept such risks on behalf of myself and/or my minor child(ren).

ON BEHALF OF MYSELF AND/OR MY MINOR CHILD(REN) NAMED ON THIS APPLICATION AND IN CONSIDERATION FOR EACH AND EVERY RIDE ON ANY CHAIRLIFT DEVICE, I HEREBY RELEASE, HOLD HARMLESS AND INDEMNIFY BRIDGER BOWL INC., ITS EMPLOYEES, AGENTS, OFFICERS AND DIRECTORS FROM ANY AND ALL LIABILITY FOR DAMAGE, ECONOMIC LOSS, PERSONAL INJURY OR DEATH TO MYSELF AND/OR MY MINOR CHILD(REN) RESULTING FROM THE RISKS DESCRIBED HEREIN, REGARDLESS OF WHETHER SUCH RISKS RESULT FROM THE NEGLIGENCE OF BRIDGER BOWL, INC., AND THE PARTIES RELEASED.

IF I AM SIGNING ON BEHALF OF A MINOR, I ACCEPT FULL RESPONSIBILITY FOR ALL MEDICAL EXPENSES OR LIABILITY INCURRED AS A RESULT OF THE MINOR'S ACTIONS OR USE OF THIS PASS AND AGREE TO RELEASE, HOLD HARMLESS AND INDEMNIFY BRIDGER BOWL INC., AND THE PARTIES RELEASED ABOVE FOR ANY SUCH EXPENSES. I AGREE TO EXPLAIN AND ENFORCE "YOUR RESPONSIBILITY CODE," BRIDGER BOWL MOUNTAIN REGULATIONS, MONTANA STATE LAW AND THE SAFETY ITEMS OUTLINED IN THIS AGREEMENT.

All Pass Holders are to read and sign this Agreement.

Pass Holders under the age of 18 are required to have a parent or legal guardian read and sign this Agreement as well.

I HAVE CAREFULLY READ THIS AGREEMENT, UNDERSTAND IT, AND ACCEPT ITS TERMS.

Season Pass Products Terms and Conditions

General

By issuing any pass product, Bridger Bowl Inc. makes no guarantees as to opening date, closing date, days of operation, lifts or trails in operation, snow conditions, availability of parking, or availability of added value benefits.

Pass holder agrees to visibly wear his/her pass or ticket whenever loading any chair lift and must present it upon demand for inspection. Failure to present your pass will result in immediate suspension. Skiers, pass holders, and ticket holders are expected to abide by "Your Responsibility Code", Bridger Bowl Inc. Mountain Regulations, Montana State Law, Section 23-2-736, 23-2-735 and 23-2-704 MCA and the Season Pass Agreement. Regulations will be enforced. Bridger Bowl Inc. reserves the right to cancel a pass and/or ticket without a refund and may refuse future purchase of pass and/or ticket for failure to comply with the regulations listed above or disregard for the safe use of lifts, slopes, or other facilities at the area.

Ages and Pricing:

For passes purchased before October 1st, pass type is determined by a person's age as of October 1st. If purchased after October 1st, a person's pass type is determined by the person's age on the date of purchase.

Unlimited Season Pass

Adult, Senior, Junior, Child

May be used any day during the operating season.

Use of the pass is restricted to the user whose name and picture appear on the pass.

This pass is Non-Transferrable. If your pass is used by another person, you may lose your pass for the remainder of the season without compensation as well as face prosecution for Theft of Services.

Forgotten Pass: In the event you have forgotten your pass you will be issued a day ticket according to the following rate schedule:

1st time = \$2.00	2nd time = \$10.00
3rd time = \$20.00	4th time = full day ticket rate

If this day ticket is found on another person you may lose your pass for the remainder of the season without compensation as well as face prosecution for Theft of Services.

Lost or Stolen Pass: Contact the Season Pass Office immediately regarding a lost or stolen pass. A replacement pass may be obtained for a non-refundable fee of the day ticket cost for child passes and \$20.00 for adult, senior and junior passes.

Mid-Week Season Pass

May be used any weekday (Mon. thru Fri.) during the operating season.

Use of the pass is restricted to the user whose name and picture appear on the pass.

This pass is Non-Transferrable. If your pass is used by another person, you may lose your pass for the remainder of the season without compensation as well as face prosecution for Theft of Services.

If you wish to ski on a weekend day, present your pass at the ticket window for a reduced rate on an adult full day lift ticket. (1/2 day rate for full day)

Forgotten Pass: In the event you have forgotten your pass you will be issued a day ticket according to the following rate schedule:

1st time = \$2.00	2nd time = \$10.00
3rd time = \$20.00	4th time = full day ticket rate

If this day ticket is found on another person you may lose your pass for the remainder of the season without compensation as well as face prosecution for Theft of Services.

Lost or Stolen Pass: Contact the Season Pass Office immediately regarding a lost or stolen pass. A replacement pass may be obtained for a non-refundable fee of \$20.00.

Ten Time Pass

Punch Card

May be used any day of the operating season not to exceed ten days. Limited to one ticket per day. The pass must be presented at a ticket window to obtain a lift ticket. Use of the pass or ticket is restricted to the user whose name and picture appear on the pass.

This pass is Non-Transferrable.

If your pass or ticket is used by another person, you may lose your pass for the remainder of the season without compensation as well as face prosecution for Theft of Services.

Lost or Stolen Pass: The pass is not replaceable and use is only tracked on the card. If you lose the pass, the remaining value is gone and cannot be recovered
